

School Uniform Policy

Introduction

All students are required to wear the school uniform when attending school or when representing the school at any event.

Aims and Objectives:

Our policy is based on the notion that the school uniform:

- Identifies the students with the school.
- Promotes a sense of pride.
- Fosters equity among students.

The Role of Teachers:

All teachers are required to ensure that students wear the school uniform as defined by the school administration.

The Role of Parents:

We ask all parents to support the school uniform code as mentioned in the school ALMANAC. Parents will be notified if their child is in violation of the school uniform code.

On dress-down days, parents must ensure that students are modestly dressed. T-shirts with objectionable words, phrases, and symbols should be avoided.

The Role of the Student Council:

The Student Council members are responsible for ensuring that all students adhere to the school uniform policy and report any violation to the Grade Coordinator.

Redressal:

Failure to wear proper school uniform may lead to disciplinary action determined by the administration. If the student continues to violate the policy, stringent action will be taken.

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
