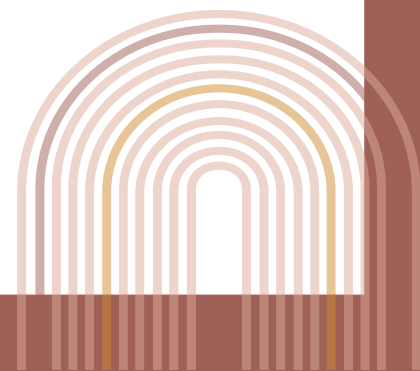
Also, to promote health and well-being, Grades 2 to 4 participated in a Dental Camp aimed at raising awareness about dental hygiene and its importance for overall well-being.

FUN TRIP

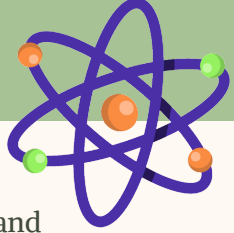

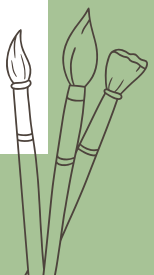




ART AND MATH EXHIBITION

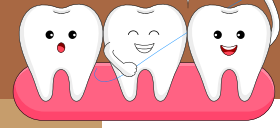


JOY OF READING

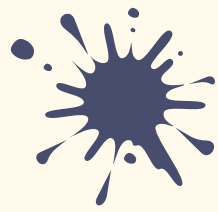


CPD Session
