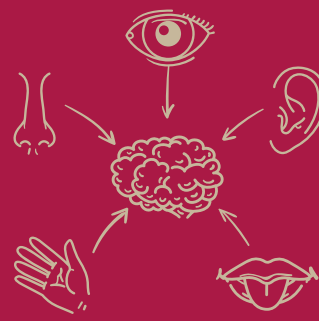

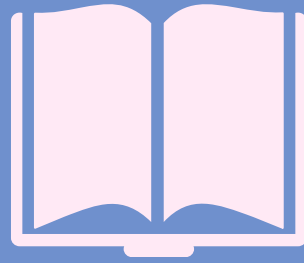
# SENSORY DAY

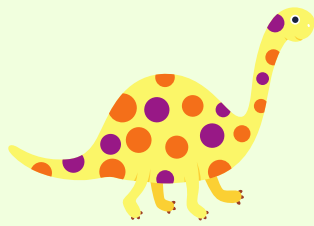
# MYSTERY READER

# RED DAY



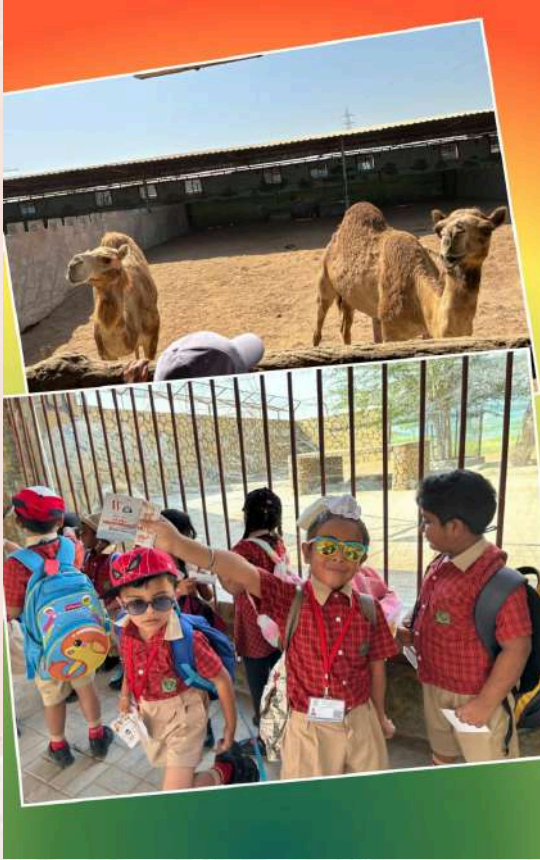

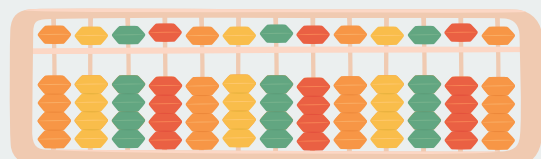




# Mental Math Interhouse

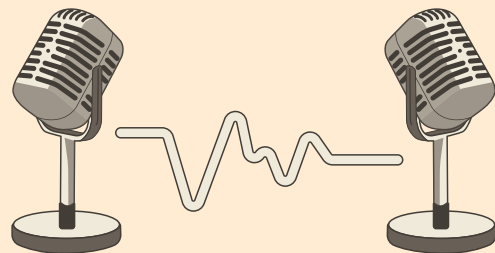

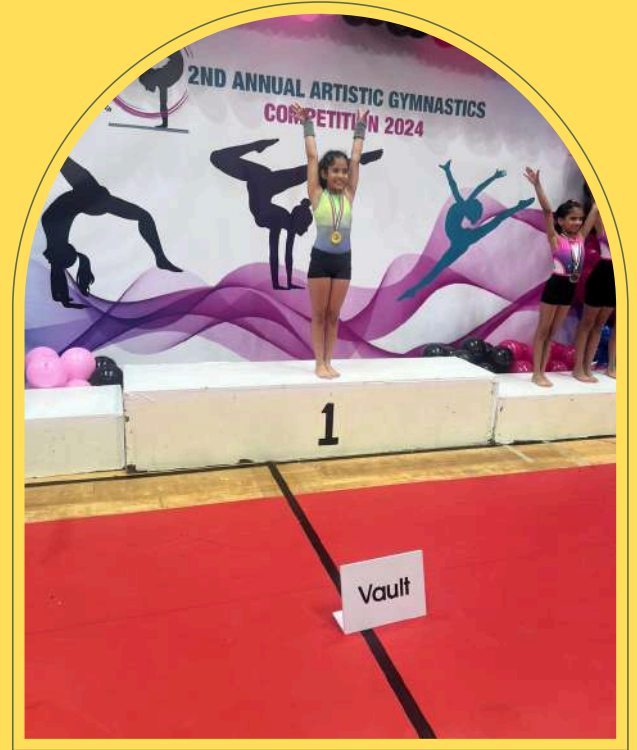


# ACHIEVEMENTS
