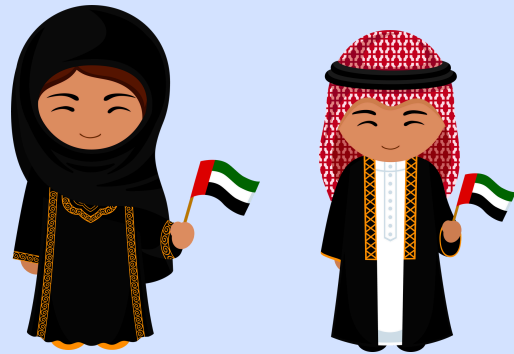

**A big shoutout to our young speakers for an informative session that raised awareness about safe internet use and caring for the environment!**



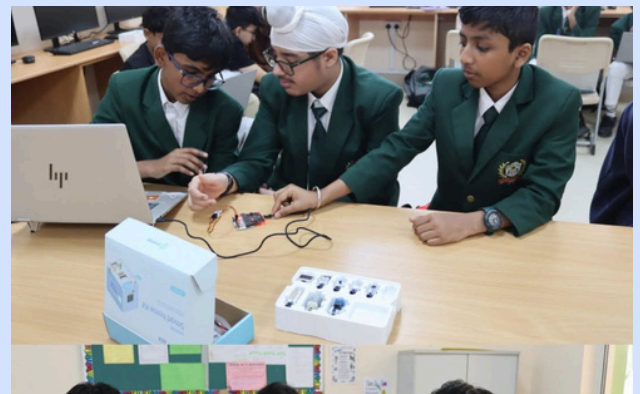


# Technophile 4.0

# Financial Literacy Session

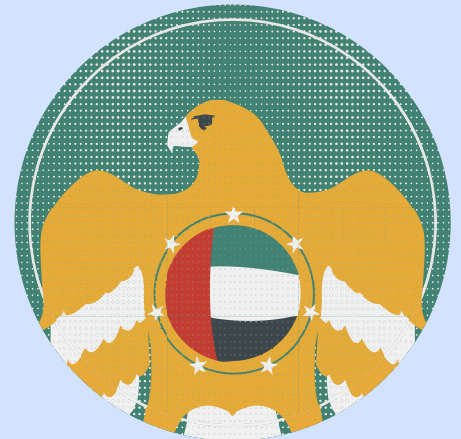
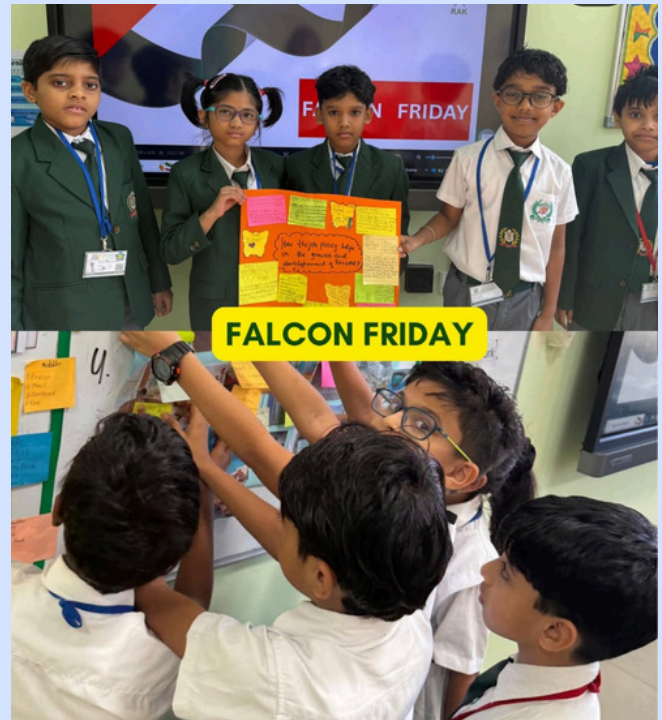

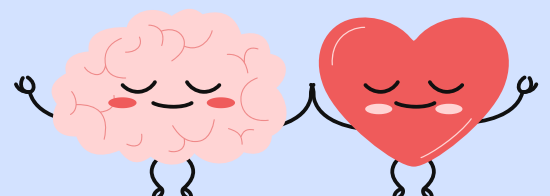
