A staff awareness session on Child Protection and Safeguarding was successfully conducted, with a focused emphasis on supporting Students of Determination (SOD).

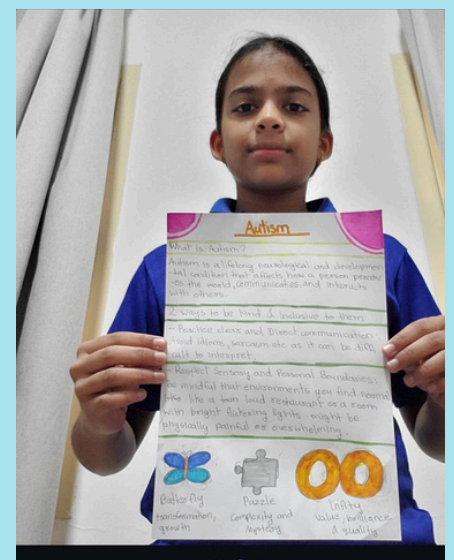
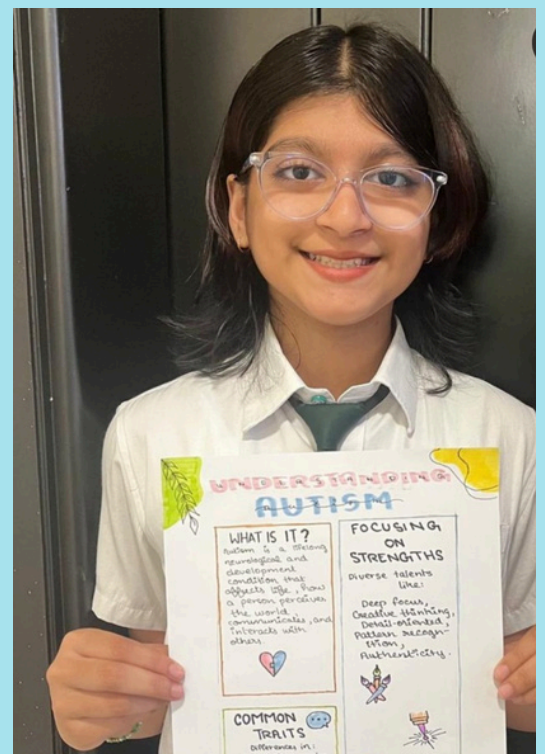
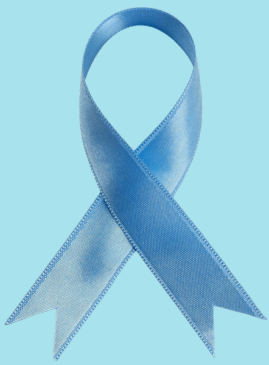
The session addressed key strategies for ensuring student safety, well-being, and inclusion within the classroom environment.

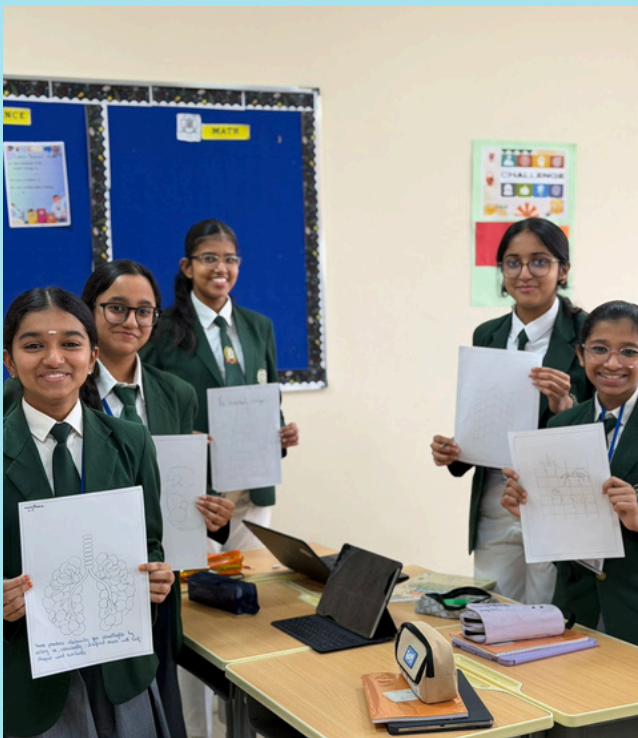
# International Creativity and Innovation Day

# World Earth Day



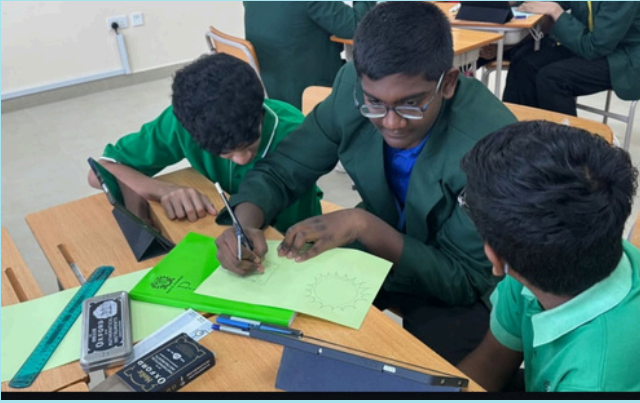

**Readathon brought the entire school community together to celebrate the power of literacy. From our youngest learners to our senior students and staff, everyone united to cultivate a shared love for books.**

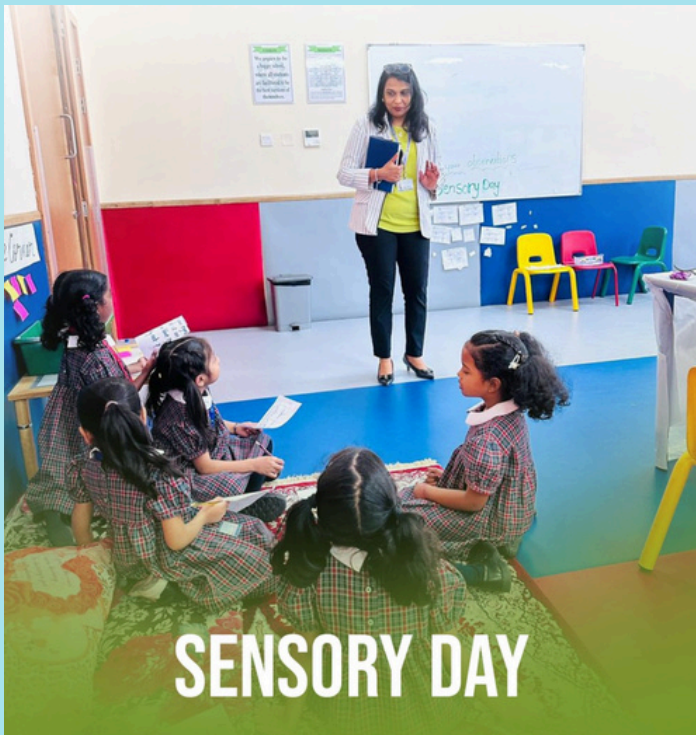

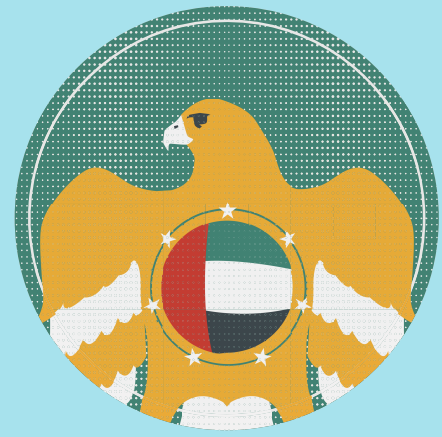
# Sensory Day

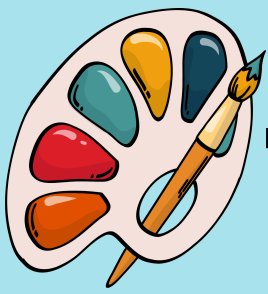

3

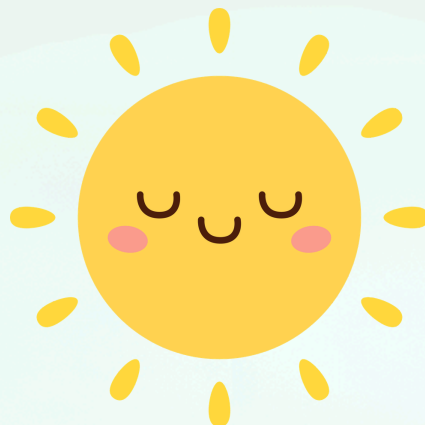
Show yourself some compassion by thinking kind thoughts about yourself.
