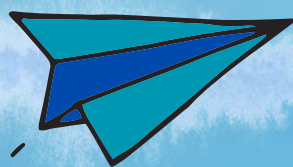

Our young learners celebrated World Environment Day through engaging activities that encouraged love and care for the environment.



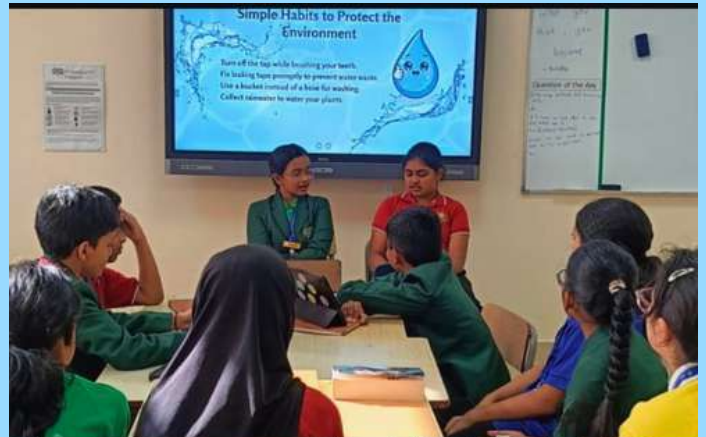
Environment Week Activity week 2

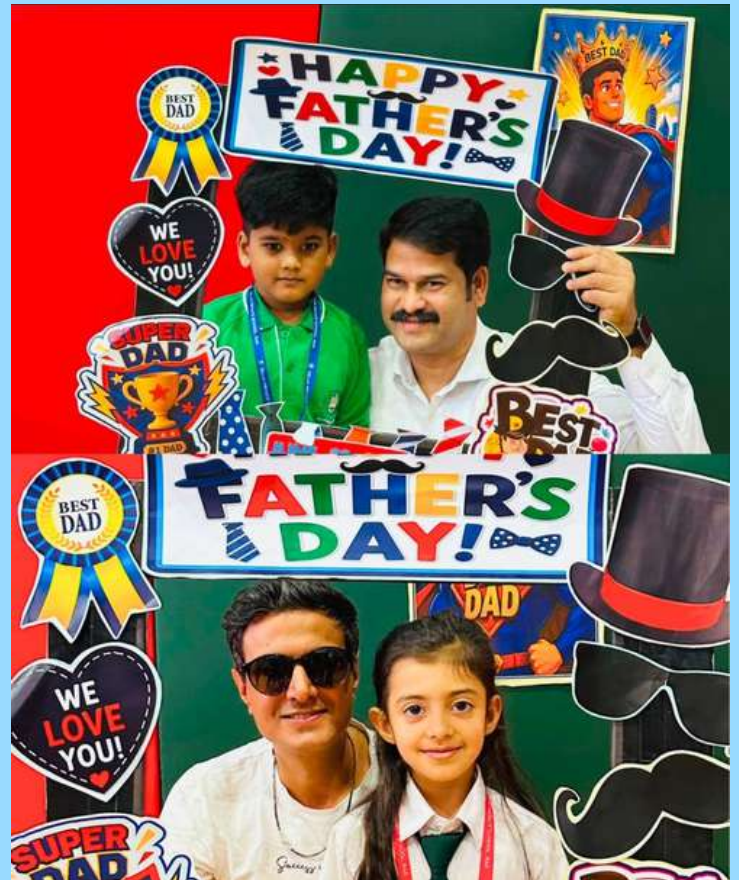


Father's Day Celebration

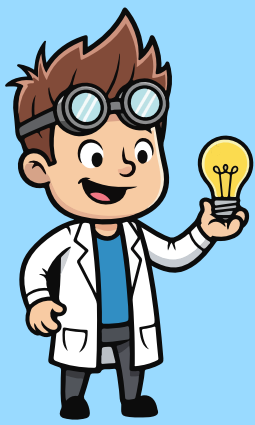
Solo Dance Competition

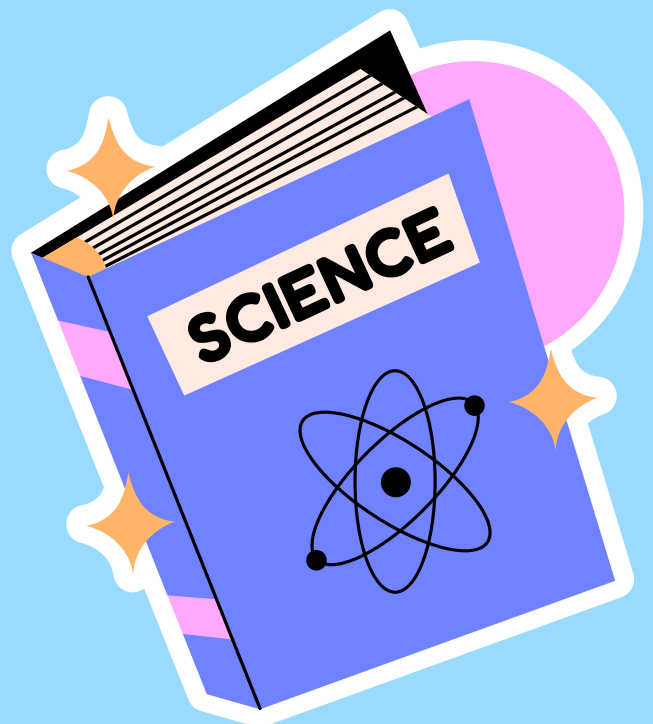
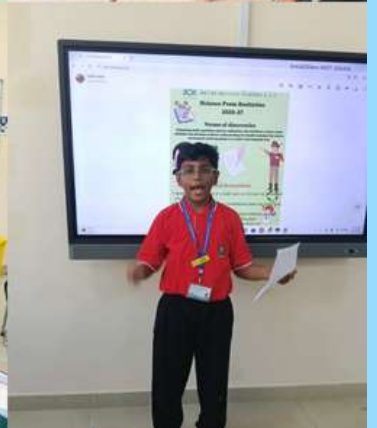

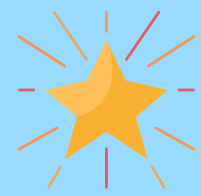
The verses of discovery

Science poem recitation event. A beautiful blend of science and poetry, where young minds expressed their curiosity, creativity, and love for learning through inspiring verses.



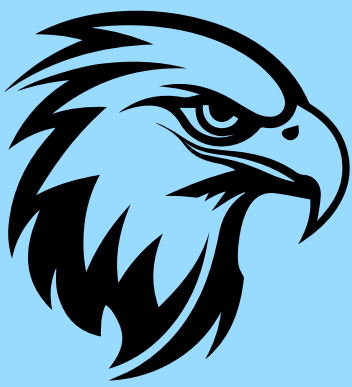


Thrive Thursday

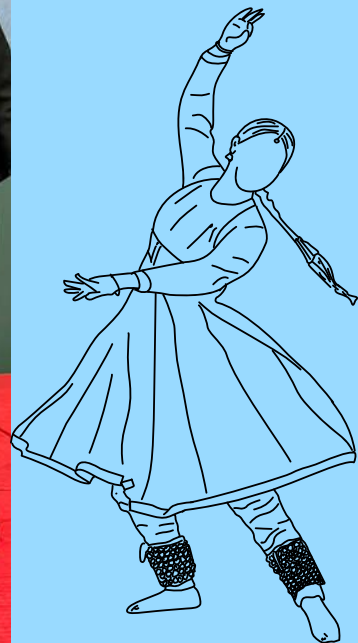

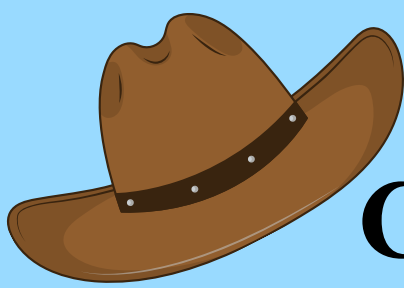

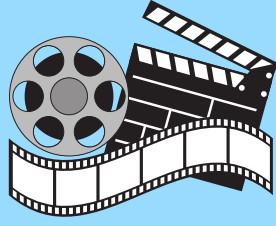
Creative Hat Day
